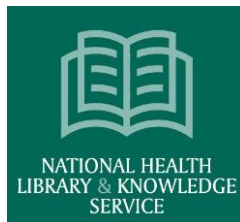

<b>Summary of problem or reason for enquiry</b>	<p>To enhance accessibility to information for clinicians (primarily nurses) who work on the campus of Cherry Orchard which accommodates Older Persons, Addiction, Child &amp; Adolescent mental health, Public Health Nursing services &amp; Primary Care centre. Local access would support &amp; encourage staff to use the library facilities which in turn would support promotion of evidence based practice, person centred care and research and potential support integration across services. The Librarian in Central Library Dr Steevens engage and keen to support the initiative from the outset.</p>
<b>Brief description of the information found / service provided</b>	<p>Baseline survey was formulated with librarian and conducted to explore current use of library facilities and identify appetite for a local resource. The findings indicated a requirement for access to library facilities on site. A library committee was established co chaired by Librarian to progress the initiative and to agree governance structures surrounding the initial pilot.</p>
<b>Summary of outcome and impact</b>	<p>The library was formally opened April 2015 for one year pilot period. Evaluation following this period demonstrated significant activity in relation to the library. Staff reported interest in continuing with the initiative. Librarian committed to continue to support this facility. The facility is available today and continues to be used by all grades of staff who work within Cherry Orchard Campus.</p>
<b>Immediate Impact (including quotes)</b>	<p>Since set up the satellite services has recorded the following activities;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 209 visits to the library</li> <li>• 97 Clinical queries have been completed</li> <li>• 10 Group Training sessions covering CAMHs, Older Persons, Addiction Services, TUSLA and professional groups such as Occupational Therapists and Psychologists. Outreach training was also provided to Mental Health Teams and Speech and Language Therapist in the community.</li> <li>• Special event included presentation on Challenging Behaviour delivered by Librarian on dementia ward</li> <li>• Pop up yoga class promoting physical activity and in celebration of</li> </ul>
