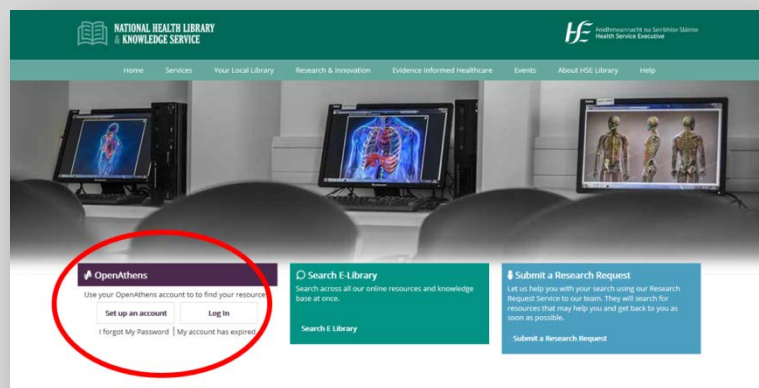


Short Guide to OpenAthens



OpenAthens provides you with a username and password to access resources purchased by the Library service 24/7 from any Internet-enabled computer. You can set up or renew your OpenAthens account on the library website at www.hselibrary.ie.
